## **SPORTING CODE OF CONDUCT FOR CHILDREN & YOUNG PLAYERS**

We all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behaviour in the game.

As a player, you have a big part to play. That's why The FA are asking every player to follow a Respect Code of Conduct. The England Netball association have also agreed a set of core values including Respect, Teamwork, Achievement and Fun.

### **When playing sport, I will:**

- Always play to the best of my ability
- Play fairly – I won't cheat, complain or waste time
- Respect my team-mates, the other team, the referee or my coach/manager
- Play by the rules, as directed by the referee
- Shake hands with the other team and referee at the end of the game
- Listen and respond to what my coach/team manager tells me
- Take care of equipment owned by the club
- Keep yourself safe
- Show respect to other youth members/leaders and show team spirit
- Refrain from the use of bad language and inappropriate behaviour
- Refrain from bullying or persistent use of rough and dangerous play
- To always adhere to CMSAUK Statement of Policy.
- Talk to someone I trust or the club welfare officer if I'm unhappy about anything at my club.

**I understand that if I do not follow the Code, any/all of the following actions may be taken by my club, the relevant County governing body or the actual governing body (The FA, England Netball) etc.**

### **I may:**

- Be required to apologise to my team-mates, the other team, referee or team manager
- Receive a formal warning from the coach or the club committee
- Be dropped or substituted
- Be suspended from training
- Be required to leave the club.

### **In addition:**

- My club, the relevant County governing body or the actual governing body (The FA, England Netball) etc. may make my parent or carer aware of any infringements of the Code of Conduct and could implement sanctions.
